CORE OFFER	We are able to deliver our core offer consistently across all areas of our school. We offer KS1 and KS2 Nurture groups as well as a range of SEMH support groups and interventions across the school and we have trained staff to support pupils with emotional needs.
POLICIES	Our support staff are trained to provide a range of quality interventions. The following policies are displayed on our website: SEN Safeguarding Behaviour Equality and Diversity
RANGE OF PROVISION	We are aware and familiar with the requirements of the Disability Discrimination Act 1995 and the Equality Act 2010 Fully equipped disabled facility including shower, bed, toilet and hand wash facility Disabled toilet and shower Early Intervention Officer on staff as well as access to Parent and Family support worker, who supports parents/carers and offer advice on various issues. Early Intervention Officer to support with attendance. Breakfast and after school clubs are available from 7:30am – 6pm Range of extra-curricular enrichment clubs which are run on a term/half termly basis. These are mainly free and available to all pupils subject to space; only some require a small fee. We have access to specialist support for times when the school are unable to meet the specific needs of a child
INCLUSION	Lessons are as inclusive as possible, with adjustments made depending on need. Children with disabilities are included on all school visits and residential opportunities.
PARENT SUPPORT INVOLVEMENT/ LIAISON:	Children with SEND work closely with the Class teacher, SENCO, and outside agencies. Home/school link books are in place where needed. Parent evenings are held termly with a written report in the summer term. In addition to this, children with higher level SEN have a SEN Support Review and pupils with EHCPs have Annual Reviews.
OTHER INFORMATION	We have carefully planned and structured transition programmes in place to support transition between key stages and between schools. Intervention programmes are used at Manor Court. These are delivered either by a teacher or an LSA
