3	Behaviour at the school is good	89% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.
4	My child is not bullied or harassed at the school	78% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.
5	Teaching is good	92% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.
6	I am kept well informed about my child's progress	79% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.
7	I feel comfortable about approaching the school with questions or problems	90% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.
8	Staff expect my child to work hard and do his/her best	94% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.
9	The school is well led and managed	80% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.
10	Staff treat my child fairly	90% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.
11	The school seeks the views of parents and takes account of their suggestions	70% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.
12	Staff explain how I can help my child at home and provide appropriate homework	78% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.
13	Staff encourage my child to become mature and independent	92% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.
14	There is a good range of activities that interest my child	75% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.
15	There is a good range of extra-curricular activities	59% of 105 responses strongly agreed or agreed with this statement.

Result	Actions taken/in progress
78% of parents who responded feel that their child is not bullied or harassed at school	We have just revised our behaviour policy (which can be viewed on the school website) and we assure you that any concern in regards to bullying is dealt with very seriously.
79% of parents who responded feel that they are kept well informed about their child's progress	From September, dates for parents evenings will be published via the newsletter and website well in advance. We will also be holding curriculum evenings for parents.
70% of parents who responded feel that the school seeks the views of parents.	Regular parent forums take place led by members of the senior leadership team. Please also note that we have an open door policy here at the end of each day if you need to speak to a member of staff.
78% of parents who responded feel that staff provide appropriate homework.	There has been an increased expectation on homework this year, please expect this to continue from September. The current policy is under review.
59% of parents who responded feel that there is a good range of extra-curricular activities.	The new leadership team agree and from September there will be over 20 clubs for the children to choose from and many will be free. A separate letter is being sent out informing you of the clubs on offer.
