## **Reference: End of Year 6 enrichment week Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June – Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2021**

This year due to the ongoing coronavirus pandemic the traditional week-long residential for Year 6 has not been possible to arrange. However, we have been able to create a week (Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June – Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2021) of activities that we believe will be as varied and interesting as the usual residential trip.

The week will be as follows:

Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June: Art project, the children will be creating two art projects for the local community with Mrs Morton.

Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> June: Cooking masterclass with a local chef and Water fight in the afternoon (from the Manor Court 48).

Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June – Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July: Huish woods camp **unless Government restrictions prevent this from happening and we will then camp on the school field using equipment used from one of the Local Scout packs.**

Our hope is that the residential camp can take place at Huish woods scout camp. The children will indoor camp in the Govett hall and all food, drink and snacks for the children will be included. The campsite has a complete kitchen and multiple showering blocks as well as a shop and large screen tv for our movie night (another part of the Manor Court 48). The activities during this camp will include:

- Archery
- Zip Wire
- Orienteering
- Woodland Skills
- Caving (dependant on Covid restrictions at time of visit)
- Climbing (dependant on adding Schools in HW Insurance Policy)
- Den building, camp games and campfires.

Please be aware that this year because of Covid restrictions it will be the responsibility of parents to arrange transport for their child to and from the Huish campsite.
