Year 5 Trip - Exeter

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Manor Court 48 offer to 'visit a city', Year 5 will be taking a trip to Exeter on **Thursday, 11th July 2024**.

The children will be leaving Manor Court promptly at 9:00am and will travel to Exeter city centre. We will be completing a 'Walking Tour' of parts of the city, including a look at some Roman remains and to see the cathedral from the outside. Sadly, the cathedral is closed for a private ceremony and a large part of the inside is inaccessible due to unearthing works, but we will still be able to appreciate its grandeur and architecture from the outside. We will eat our lunch in Northenhay Gardens, which is a large park close to the Royal Albert Memorial Museum (RAMM). We are booked in for a visit at the museum and here, the pupils will experience a range of galleries and see thousands of artefacts! We will then return by coach to be back in time for the end of the day at 3.15pm.

This trip will provide lots of cross-curricular learning for our pupils on the topics they covered through Year 5: Christianity in R.E, Anglo-Saxons in History, Settlements in Geography and architecture in Art.

The children will need to wear school uniform for the trip and will be provided with high-visibility jackets so they can be easily identified throughout the day. Your child will need a sun hat, sun cream and a waterproof coat for any unpredictable weather.

As we have some distance to travel, please could you ensure that your child is in school promptly at 8.45am so that we can leave on time at 9.00am, in good time to reach Exeter. Children will need to bring a packed lunch, however children who are entitled to free school meals or have paid for a school meal will be provided with a packed lunch. It would be particularly helpful if you could pack your child's lunch in a labelled plastic bag that can be thrown away after use. As we are a healthy school, we would kindly ask for no fizzy drinks or sweets. An extra snack and drink is advisable for all children.

The children will be able to access the gift shop in the museum and may bring in a maximum of £5.00 to spend, which they will be responsible for.


Children may bring a book to read or a small toy or game to play with on the coach however no electrical items, including phones or electronic tablets are permitted for security reasons. Mobile telephones brought into school in the morning will be kept locked at school until we return. Please advise us if your child gets travel sick and make any necessary arrangements for medication to be given before they leave.

The visit will cost **£7.85** per child. Payment for this trip will need to be made through your ParentPay account by no later than **Friday 5th July**.
