### **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2024**

### **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2024**

Unless your child is in Year 4 (Puffins and Eagles) they **must** wear their school uniform, unless it is their usual PE Day.

Children in Year 4 are having their Times Table Rockstar day as arranged by Mrs Wilkins and Miss Langdown. If they wish they can come to school dressed as a 'Rock Star'! If they do not wish to dress as a 'Rock-Star' they **must** come to school in their school uniform.

### **Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2024**

The FMCA are holding their annual Summer Fete, after school, on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June. The FMCA have asked to hold a school uniform day for donations to the items used as prizes in the Fete. All children (apart from those in Y2 – Magpies and Nightingales class) can come to school wearing non-school uniform and this is another opportunity for the Y6 children to wear their leavers hoodies. The list of items that the FMCA would like to receive are in the table below. Please give your donation to your child's teacher in the morning and this will be collected by the FMCA from there.

<b>Year 1 &amp; Year 5</b>	An item for the Treat Tombola - Sweets, chocolate, biscuits etc.
<b>Year 2 &amp; Year 6</b>	An item for the Activity Tombola – A sporting item, toys or games

The Year 2 children are on their exciting trip to Noah's Ark Zoo and **must wear** their school uniform for ease of child identification throughout this day. Year 2 children will have their FMCA non-school uniform day on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June instead.

### Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2024

On Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June we are holding our EYFS and KS1 Euro football day and weather permitting this day will involve a day of football on the field for our youngest children. Children in the EYF, Foundation Stage (Squirrels and Hedgehogs), Year 1 (Bumblebees and Dragonflies) and Year 2 (Magpies and Nightingales) should wear their PE kits to school.

Children in Key Stage 2 **must wear** their school uniform to school.

Due to staff training, Miss Clarke will not be running her 'Sing and Sign' club. All other after school enrichment clubs will be running as normal throughout the week.

### Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2024

On Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June we are holding our Key Stage 2 Euro competition and weather permitting our oldest children will be playing football throughout the day on the school field.

All children (regardless of the year group that they are in) can wear an England football shirt/kit, or the shirt/kit of another country or football team.

If they prefer, they can wear red and white clothing that is suitable for sporting activities. This is another opportunity for children in Year 6 to wear their leaver hoodies.

We are allowing children to have their face painted with flags of the country that they are supporting should they wish to.

We appreciate that there are a lot of enrichment activities taking place and we hope that this letter will ensure clarity for you.
