Year 3 Trip to Lyme Regis Museum, Wednesday 20th March 2024

To complement our new story 'Stone girl, bone girl' and link in with our last science topic 'Rocks and fossils'. Year 3 will be visiting Lyme Regis Museum on Wednesday 20th March 2024. The trip will also be a chance to continue our work and research about Mary Anning and her incredible discoveries.

We will leave school at 9.15am and return in time for normal pick-up at 3.15pm. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink. The trip will cost **£11.13** per child, payment and sign up via ParentPay need to be made by **Wednesday 6th March 2024 at the latest.**

Please note, there may be an opportunity for children to visit the gift shop in small groups. Children may bring a maximum of £5.00 in a named envelope/purse.
