'Chard Together' – Additional information

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have been sent some information in addition to and slightly different to that which was sent out on Tuesday.

If your child participates in the dragon parade on Saturday 9th March, and wears the mask they decorated in school, they will receive a chocolate egg (there will be a few dairy free too). Children will bring their masks home in the week leading up to the event. The parade will start at the Guildhall at 10:00am.

The dragon art competition is open to all the children, grouped into these age categories: - 4-7, 8-11, 12-14, 15-18. The theme is to create a dragon that represents something that is important to your child, such as their family, home, town, environment or a feeling like courage or love. Any art medium may be used, apart from AI. There will be prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each category, and will be judged by the Lord Lieutenant of Somerset and Mayor of Chard. All entries will be displayed in the Guildhall on the 9th of March.

The entries must be handed in to the Guildhall no later than **Tuesday 5th of March (in the previous letter it said by the 8th)**, with the Child's name, age and a contact number attached. You can also send them into school by Monday 4th March and I will take them to the Guildhall. We have a lot of very talented artists in our school, so it would be lovely to see lots of entries from Manor Court!

Our Year 6 Arts Councillors have decorated a dragon egg for the Chard Together egg hunt. The hunt will take place around the town centre between the 1st and 9th of March. Each egg will be numbered and maps for the egg hunt will be available from the Guildhall a week before and during the dragon egg hunt week. They will also be available on the 2nd of March at the Chard Together market stall.

If your child is in Choir or Y4,5 or 6 Dance Club, we have no exact timings for the performance yet, but anticipate it to be around 11:00am. We will update you when we know for sure.
