DANCE CLUB – SUMMER SHOW AND DRESS REHEARSAL

Dear Parents and Carers,

You will have received a letter via Parent Pay, with information about our Summer show. Please give consent for both performances by **Friday 7th June**. Dance Club will return for all year groups for our final practices all together on Wednesday 5th June. Please make sure your child is wearing their PE kit to school each Wednesday, as we will have around 50 dancers, so it will be logistically more sensible for them to already be in the correct clothing. The finishing time of both sessions of Dance Club (5th & 12th June) is 4:30pm. If they participate in another club on a Wednesday this term, please can they miss that club on these two occasions. I will inform club leaders of this.

We will have a dress rehearsal for all Dance Clubs (plus the Drama Club - those club leaders will send out a letter too) straight after school on **Monday 17th June, at Holyrood School**. We will walk to Holyrood straight after school. Please make arrangements to collect them from the front entrance of Holyrood at **6:00pm** and give consent by **Friday 7th June via your ParentPay account**.

For the dress rehearsal, dancers will need to bring their dance clothes to change into, an extra drink/refillable bottle that they can top up at school, snacks, and a hairbrush. Dance clothes: black leggings/slim fit joggers, dark trainers (if possible) and dark trainer socks (if possible). They will be given their coloured t-shirt at the dress rehearsal (unless they still have it from the Westlands show), along with any other costume accessories. Please can long hair be tied back, but as it may get rather dishevelled over the day, if they bring a brush with them, that will help when re-doing/tidying up hair for the rehearsal. No buns this year! Hair to be tied back however you want, as long as a hair grip (like they wore at the last show) for Years 4,5,6 can be slid in, and a headband can be put on for Y2/3 (they are wearing deeley boppers).

They will wear their coloured t-shirt home with them after the dress rehearsal, so please ensure they come to the shows wearing it. If you wish to wash it between shows, please do so at 30 degrees, as they shrink easily!

We will take photos of each group in full costume at the dress rehearsal which will again be for sale at £1 each to help raise funds for future costumes. Forms to buy these photos will be sent out the week after the show. We will apply a small amount of non-toxic face glitter just to add a little more sparkle. It comes off easily with a face wipe or water and a flannel. Please let me know if they cannot have face glitter.

On show nights, please can they be brought to the front entrance of Holyrood School between 5:00pm and 5:15pm, wearing their coloured t-shirt, black leggings/slim joggers, dark trainers and dark socks, with long hair tied back. They should bring a drink and some snacks as the show will finish around 8:00pm.
