## ARTS COUNCILLORS - SUMMER SHOW AND DRESS REHEARSAL

Dear Parents and Carers,

You will have already received a letter via parent pay about our Summer Show. Please ensure you have given consent for both shows by **Friday 7th June**.

As an Arts Councillor, your child will be one of our hosts for both shows, introducing the acts, giving thanks etc. They are welcome to wear something a little snazzier than the coloured top and dark bottoms the rest of their class will be wearing. They could wear a party dress/bridesmaid dress/smart shirt and trousers/skirt/suit if they have one from a wedding/Christening etc. Please consider ease for changing if they are in Dance Club.

If your child isn't already participating in the dress rehearsal on **Monday 17th June** for Dance Club or Drama Club, they are welcome to join us and have a chance to practice introducing acts on stage, with a microphone. Please can we ask that you provide consent via your ParentPay account if they will be attending the dress rehearsal. They do not need to stay for the whole of the dress rehearsal as it is quite long! It finishes at 6pm, so if you wish to collect them earlier, please let us know via the school office and we will bring them outside to meet you. This can be from 5:00pm. They can stay in their school uniform and bring an extra drink and some snacks. They will be photographed in their hosting clothes during one of the shows.

They will be given their scripts next week for practicing at home but will be given another copy of them for the shows, which they can have on stage with them. They do not need to learn their words by heart, just be as familiar with them as possible, so that they can introduce acts confidently, and not look like they are reading them for the first time.

On show days, please can they arrive at Holyrood between 5:00pm and 5:15pm wearing their presenting outfit and bring any dance clothing, snacks, and a drink with them. They will sell programmes when the doors open for the audience at 5:30pm. The shows will start at 6:00pm and end around 8:00pm.
