### Club Descriptions

Club Name	Description
Homework	Homework club provides an opportunity for the children to complete their homework in a familiar environment with supportive resources, adults, and peers.
Times Tables	Times Table Rockstar Club is an opportunity for children to practice their times tables which have been individually personalised for every child to help improve their speed.
Colouring Club	Colouring club is an opportunity for your child's artistic skills to flourish.

Brainbusters Club	Brainbusters is a club that challenges your brain power.... In a fun way. Over the weeks we will do word search competitions, play games involving numbers, look at logic problems and solve clues to exercise our brains and win prizes. So, get your thinking caps on and come join the fun.
Drama Club	Drama club is a lovely opportunity for children to play games and express themselves. We look at lots of different stories and most importantly have lots of fun! We are working towards a performance.
Dance Club	Children will be taught a variety of dance styles in preparation for performances at our Whole School Show in the Summer Term.
Choir Club	Singing group with planned community activities
Drawing Club	For all abilities to develop or improve their drawing skills. Children will watch a short video on how to draw something. They will then apply this independently following the steps. Once they have finished drawing, they will be able to add colour and a background to it!
Sing and Sign	We will be singing a new song each week using sign language
Multi Sports	A variety of sporting activities, learning new skills and sports throughout the session.
Yoga Club	Yoga practice can promote endurance, strength, calmness, flexibility, and well-being.
Basketball	A game which will teach confidence and team work all whilst having fun!
Football	An opportunity for children in Year 5 and 6 to take part in a team sport and learn football skills.
Tag Rugby	A team sport to learn skills and resilience.
