Dear Parents/Carers,

To celebrate the Christmas season, we have planned for Christmas party afternoons.

Key Stage 1: Christmas party on the afternoon of **Wednesday 18th December 2024**

Key Stage 2: Christmas party on the afternoon of **Thursday 19th December 2024**

On these days, children may come to school wearing party clothes if it is the afternoon of their party. Please note Wednesday 18th is also our Living Nativity Day, so our Key Stage 1 pupils may bring in their traditional Nativity costume to change into for photographs if they wish.

This year, we would be grateful if the children could bring in a **small amount** of snack type food e.g., crisps, cheesy biscuits, small cakes, chocolate biscuits and sandwiches (nothing which requires refrigeration please). Please **DO NOT** send in any nut-based foods as we are a nut free school.

You only need to provide enough food for your own child, as it will not be shared with others, drinks will be provided for them. Although we are a 'healthy school' we think that this type of food will be more appropriate for the party as a Christmas treat!

We will be sending home a paper bag which your child can decorate with a Christmas theme of their own choice to bring to the party, filled with snacks for only them to eat.

Lunchtimes will work as normal, so if your child usually has a hot lunch, they will still receive this, if your child normally brings in a packed lunch, please can you make sure you still provide them with one.

Christmas Jumper Days. – No donation required.

Children are able to come to school on the days below in a Christmas jumper, please note that other than the jumper, normal uniform should be worn.

KS2 – Friday 13th December

On Friday 20th December, it is non-uniform for all pupils to celebrate the last day of the school.
