Club Name	Description
Homework	Homework club provides an opportunity for the children to complete their homework in a familiar environment with supportive resources, adults, and peers.
Times Tables	Times Table Rockstar Club is an opportunity for children to practice their times tables which have been individually personalised for every child to help improve their speed.
Colouring Club	Colouring club is an opportunity for your child's artistic skills to flourish.
Brainbusters	Brainbusters is a club that challenges your brain power.... In a fun way. Over the weeks we will do word search competitions, play

Brainbusters Club	games involving numbers, look at logic problems and solve clues to exercise our brains and win prizes. So, get your thinking caps on and come join the fun.
Drama Club	Drama club is a lovely opportunity for children to play games and express themselves. We look at lots of different stories and most importantly have lots of fun! We are working towards a performance.
Dance Club	Children will be taught a variety of dance styles in preparation for performances at our Whole School Show in the Summer Term.

Dough Disco	Dough Disco involves moulding Play-Doh in time to music and performing different actions to build fine and gross motor skills. It is a fun way to build strength in the hands and prepare children for writing. After we have practised the skills, children can then use this and their imaginations to create their own Play-Doh masterpiece for fun.
Sing and Sign	We will be singing a new song each week using sign language
Yoga Club	Yoga practice can promote endurance, strength, calmness, flexibility, and well-being.
