Year 5 – Exeter Trip

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Manor Court 48 offer to 'visit a city', Year 5 will be taking a trip to Exeter on **Thursday 6th February 2025**.

The children will be leaving Manor Court promptly at 8.30am and will travel to Exeter city centre. Our first visit will be to Exeter Cathedral. We will have a tour of the building and build on our R.E. learning of Christianity. We will then have lunch. After lunch we will walk to the Royal Albert Memorial Museum (RAMM). Here, the pupils will experience a range of galleries and see thousands of artefacts! We will then return by coach to be back in time for the end of the day at 3.15pm.

The visit will cost **£7.52 per child**. Payment for this trip will need to be made through your ParentPay account. This cost includes the cathedral tour and the cost of transport.

The children will need to wear school uniform for the trip and will be provided with high-visibility jackets so they will be easily identified throughout the day. Your child will need a waterproof coat.

As we have some distance to travel, please could you ensure that your child is in school promptly at 8.15am so that we can leave at 8.30am. Children will need to bring a packed lunch, however children who are entitled to free school meals or have paid for a school meal will be provided with a packed lunch. It would be particularly helpful if you could pack your child's lunch in a labelled plastic bag that can be thrown away after use. As we are a healthy school, we would kindly ask for no fizzy drinks or sweets. An extra snack and drink are advisable for all children.

The children will be able to access the gift shop in both the cathedral and the museum and so may bring in a maximum of £5.00 to spend, which they will be responsible for.

Children may bring a book to read or a small toy or game to play with on the coach however no electrical items, including phones or electronic tablets are permitted for security reasons. Mobile telephones brought into school in the morning will be kept locked at school until we return. Please advise us if your child gets travel sick and make any necessary arrangements for medication to be given before they leave.

Please login to your ParentPay account to sign up and make payment for this trip by **Friday 31st January** at the latest.
