



Year 3 Curriculum Plan - Autumn

English

We will start with a focus on the key grammatical skills and spelling rules needed in Year 3. Daily spelling and handwriting will take place in class.

We will be studying the books, *Leon and the Place Between* and *The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark* to create different types of writing such as descriptive, poetry, instructions and narratives.

Maths

We will start with place value and understanding of three-digit numbers followed by securing strategies for addition and subtraction, multiplication, and division. We will do daily arithmetic and practice times tables.

We will build on knowledge of healthy diets and nutrition as well as learning about skeletons and muscles.
