Club Name	Description

Yoga Club	Yoga practice can promote endurance, strength, calmness, flexibility, and well-being.
Dodgeball	A team sport to learn skills and resilience.
Football	An opportunity for children to take part in a team sport and learn football skills.
Story Telling Club	They will be learning how to write their own stories in a range of genres as well as having opportunities to orally tell stories to/ with others using drama skills.
School Newspaper	We will be creating a half termly school newspaper! Children will be writing articles, taking pictures, interviewing peers and adults all whilst learning to edit and plan their own newspaper.
Nature Club	Nature Club allows your child to explore the outdoors in a way that is educational and enjoyable! Wellies are recommended.
Sewing	In sewing club, the children are learning and sharing their knowledge of basic sewing skills. The aim is for the children to work on one or two small projects over the term which will give them something to show for their commitment to the club and their newly acquired skills.
Cheerleading Club	A team sport for boys and girls where children learn stunts, jumps, tumbles, and dance for fast paced routine.
Ukulele Club	Somerset Music Academy will be coming into school to run a Ukulele Club during Monday lunchtimes in The Library. Spaces are limited but a great opportunity for your child to learn an instrument.
