## **Re: Year 5 Manor Court 48 trip to Cineworld 15.07.25**

Dear Parents and Carers,

For our final Year 5 Manor Court 48 experience (one experience each half term, for every year group), we will be visiting Cineworld, Yeovil, on **Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2025** for a private screening of **How To Train Your Dragon** (2025), a live-action remake of the animated film which came out fifteen years ago. The film is classified as PG, this means Parental Guidance may be required. PG films are reported to 'not unsettle a child aged eight years old or over.' The children will be accompanied by the Year 5 staff. It promises to be a memorable experience for all the children and will finish off a fantastic year.

The coach will be leaving Manor Court at 9:00am prompt and will be returning at lunchtime. To ensure we are all registered, toileted, and ready to depart on time, we are asking pupils to arrive from school that morning from 8.30am. The pupils can come in through the front gate at this time. Children should bring a lunch box to school with them as usual. If your child has school dinners, or you pay for a school lunch, then they will be provided with a packed lunch on this day as it likely we will not return until after 1.00pm, when the hot meals would have finished in the hall and the equipment would have been packed away. We are **happy for the children to bring their own drink and snack to the cinema**, to enjoy during the film, for example a packet of crisps, a chocolate bar or some sweets. If we feel they have brought in too much, and consequently may feel ill, this will be limited by staff. Please remember they cannot bring in foods containing nut products.

As the children will be returning to school for the afternoon, they should wear their PE kit as normal now for Tuesdays, as they will have this lesson in the afternoon.

The cost of the trip is **£7.69**. This includes the cost of the cinema ticket, which we have managed to secure at a discounted group rate, and the cost of part of the coach fee. The rest of the coach cost is going to be raised by running an ice cream sale which will be held after school on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> June 2025.

Please log in to your ParentPay account to give consent for your child to attend the trip and make payment by the end of **Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July** at the latest.

If you have any questions or queries about the arrangements for the day, please do not hesitate to get in touch with us at the end of the day, via the Office, or via your child's reading record, which are checked daily.
