Okehampton – Final Details

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we are fast approaching our exciting trip to Okehampton, we are writing to you with a few reminders about the arrangements. Final payments should now have been made, if you are still owing any outstanding payment, please make this via your ParentPay account by this **Friday 6th June** at the very latest. All paperwork must be returned to the office. The adults attending this exciting trip will be Mrs Jones, Miss Smith, Mr Clode, Miss Warren and Miss Rinaldi.

On Monday 30th June, children should bring all their luggage to Heron's classroom at the start of the school day, where they will be registered. It is important that children can carry their own bags to and from the coach. Children must bring a packed lunch and a reusable drinks bottle in a rucksack. We will be leaving at approximately 9.15am and parents are welcome to stay and wave us off.

In your information pack, you received a kit list provided by Adventure Okehampton. It is important to note that there are two water-based activities, and these may be over two days so you may wish to send your child with more than one set of swimwear. Please do ensure that each and every item is named so that we can try to reunite any lost items with their owner.

Children should not bring mobile phones or electronic gaming devices. They may however bring a camera. We suggest that a single use camera would be the most sensible option as it will be the responsibility of each child to keep it safe. If you do send your child with a digital camera, the school will take no responsibility for its safety. Mobile phone cameras are not permitted.

There is a small gift shop on site and children may bring £5 spending money if they wish. This should be given to your child's class teacher in a named purse or wallet on the morning of Monday 30th June. They may also bring a small packet of sweets for their personal consumption (nothing containing nuts, please).

On the afternoon of Wednesday 2nd July, we will be returning to school at approximately 2.30pm. We will send updates about timings via social media and ParentPay. You are encouraged to collect your child at this time, instead of waiting until the end of the school day.
