Dear parents and carers,

We are writing to you to let you know about the Year 6 enrichment week, which is a week of varied and fun activities including a residential trip. It will take place from Monday 22nd May to Friday 26th May 2023.

The plan for the week is as follows:

Monday 22nd May:

The children will be learning how to make sushi, tie-dyeing their own t-shirts, taking part in quizzes, and enjoying gourmet pancakes from the Pancake Pod.

Tuesday 23rd May:

They will have a morning of sports and burger making followed by a barbeque and games in the afternoon.

Wednesday 24th May to Friday 26th May:

Residential camp at Huish Woods Scout Camp, near Taunton. The children will be taken to and from the camp by a coach, which will depart from and return to school. The children will indoor camp in the Govett hall and adjoining rooms. All food, drink and snacks for the children will be included, except for their packed lunch on the first day. The activities that we plan to include during this residential are:

- Archery

- Woodland skills
- Artificial caving
- Orienteering

We will have an instructor for the activities that require specialised training.

The cost of the entire week's activities will be **£117.30 per child**, which can be paid in one payment or in instalments, with a **non-refundable deposit of £17.30 to be paid via your ParentPay account by November 30th at the very latest**. Residential spaces will not be available after this date.

More information and specific details about the enrichment week will be released closer to the time.
