### Yeovil Town Football Festival

Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to you to let you know that your child has been chosen to take part in a Year 3 and Year 4 Primary Stars Premier League Football Festival to be held at Yeovil Football Club's home stadium, Huish Park, on **Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> July**. The festival will involve children from other primary schools in the South Somerset area.

Your child will need to wear their PE kit into school and have a packed lunch (if you have school meals, a packed lunch will be ordered for you instead) and plenty of drinks. A sun hat, sun cream and a coat are needed too, as the weather can be variable. Your child needs to arrive in school at the earlier time of **8.30am** to ensure they are briefed and ready to leave Manor Court shortly after 8.45am. The festival will be kicking off promptly at 10.00am. Your child will leave Huish Park at 2.30pm to ensure they are back for normal home time.

The children will be split on arrival into different coloured teams and will take part in activities with pupils from other schools. There will be 5 activity stations, and your child will spend time at each one during the day: -

1. Skills Centre
2. Match Area
3. Danger Ball
4. Inflatables
5. Stadium Tour

Your child will be coming home with a paper medical and photo consent form which need to be returned as soon as possible. Children without photo consent will wear a lanyard with a purple card in, so that Club officials taking photos are aware.


Children with any medical conditions that require them to bring along medication, will wear a lanyard with a red card in. We will bring first aid trained staff from school and all Yeovil FC Trust staff are first aid trained. There will be a first aid kit at each activity along with a box for any medication that the children need with them. They will be reminded to collect any medication before they leave each activity and then asked to place it in the medication box at the next activity.

Manor Court Primary School and Yeovil FC have been working together for a number of years on reading, writing, maths and social action projects. We are pleased that the football festival is free of charge for the chosen children to participate in.

Please could you give consent for this trip via your ParentPay account no later than **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2023**.
