Year 3 – Chard Museum Visit

This term, our Year 3 curriculum topic is learning about, ‘How did the Industrial Revolution change Chard?’ We have been studying what life was like before the Industrial Revolution and how this period of time has affected the way that we live today. With this in mind, we will be visiting Chard Museum on **Wednesday 7th December 2022.**
