Part of this project involves the children being recorded moving across a green screen. These images will be turned into silhouettes so none of the children will be identifiable.

A fun and crafty activity to create beautiful papercut art using old photos of Chard for inspiration. You'll be provided with materials to make wonderful 2D papercut artworks. Images you create will feature in a series of illuminated artworks for Window Wanderland.
