The Year 4 children will be performing as the choir and the Year 5 pupils will be treading the boards and taking up the acting roles.

The Year 5 pupils have been given a costume list for their specific characters and have brought these in. We ask that the Year 4 pupils bring in a party outfit to wear for each performance – suitable for a guest at the ball! Please can these be sent into school in a labelled bag by **Friday 10<sup>th</sup> March**. If you have any difficulty in sourcing a suitable costume, please speak to your child's class teacher and we can arrange something for them to wear.

The performances are as follows: -

**Monday 27<sup>th</sup> March starting at 4.00pm – doors open at 3.45pm**

**Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> March starting at 1.30pm – doors open at 1.15pm**

**Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> March starting at 9.30am – doors open at 9.15am**

For the performance on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> March, we ask that all pupils stay at school, where they will be given a drink and snack before performing.

The performance will last approximately an hour and a half. Each family will initially be given two tickets. Tickets will be available to order via Eventbrite. An email will be sent out through ParentPay with a link to book these. The deadline to order these by is **Friday 24<sup>th</sup> March**. After this date, any spare tickets will be offered on a first come first served basis.

There will be no charge for the tickets this year, but we will be collecting donations for our chosen charity, Musgrove Children's ward.

Due to fire regulations no buggies will be allowed in the school hall, but they can be left in the corridor.
