Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our Manor Court 48 offer to 'visit a city', Year 5 will be taking a trip to Exeter on Friday, 15th July 2022.

The children will be leaving Manor Court promptly at 9:00am and will travel to Exeter city centre. Our first visit will be to Exeter Cathedral. After our tour, we will eat our packed lunches in the grounds outside. We will walk around Northernhay Gardens, which is where the Romans quarried stone from which to build the adjacent city walls and Exeter castle.

After that, we will visit the Royal Albert Memorial Museum (RAMM). We will then return by coach to be back in time for the end of the day at 3.15pm.

The visit will cost £6.24 per child. Payment for this trip will need to be made through your ParentPay account.

The children will need to wear school uniform for the trip and will be provided with high-visibility jackets so they will be easily identified throughout the day. Your child will need a sun hat, sun cream and a waterproof coat for any unpredictable weather.

As we have some distance to travel, please could you ensure that your child is in school promptly at 8.45am so that we can leave before 9.00am, in good time to reach Exeter. Children will need to bring a packed lunch, however children who are entitled to free school meals or have paid for a school meal will be provided with a packed lunch. It would be particularly helpful if you could pack your child's lunch in a labelled plastic bag with containers that can be thrown away after use. This means that the children do not have to carry their lunch boxes around the museum after lunch. As we are a healthy school, we would kindly ask for no fizzy drinks. An extra snack and drink is advisable for all children.

The children will be able to access the gift shop in both the cathedral and the museum and so may bring in a maximum of £5.00 to spend which they will be responsible for.

Children may bring a book to read, a small toy or game to play with on the coach however no electrical items, including phones or electronic tablets are permitted for security reasons. Mobile telephones brought into school in the morning will be kept locked at school until we return. Please advise us if your child gets travel sick and make any necessary arrangements for medication to be given before they leave.

Please login to your ParentPay account to sign up and make payment for this trip by Monday 11th July at the latest.
