## Reference: Class structure for the 2022-2023 academic year

We are writing to you to confirm the class structure for the 2022-2023 academic year and to inform you as to who will be your child's teacher and classroom LSA.

### Staff changes

At this time of the academic year some members of staff decide that they would like to move onto work in a different school or to leave for personal reasons.

After 12 years, Mrs Hall is leaving Manor Court at the conclusion of the academic year to become the Assistant Head Teacher at Hambridge Primary School.

After 4 years Mrs Johns is leaving to become the Head of School at Winsham Primary School and during the rest of the academic year Mrs Johns will be working three days a week at Winsham, on a Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. We are delighted to inform the Bumblebee parents that Mrs Wilkins will be the class teacher for Bumblebee class on these days.

We are thrilled for Mrs Hall and Mrs Johns and wish them well in the next stages of their career.

Mr Netherway and Miss Berry have decided to leave Manor Court at the end of the academic year to teach at schools closer to where they live. Miss Moore is also leaving us at the end of the academic year to relocate to Bristol to be with her partner.

After twenty-seven years working at Manor Court, Mrs Stoker has resigned to enable her to look after her elderly parents. Mrs Stoker will be a big loss to the school community and has touched the lives of many children and their families within our school. Miss Bilboe, a Learning Support Assistant in Y3 has been accepted onto the course to complete her PGCE in September and we anticipate and hope that she will complete her Schools Direct training at Manor Court from September. We are interviewing next week for two LSAs to replace Mrs Stoker and Miss Bilboe.

We are delighted to welcome Miss Nakamoto, Miss Hamilton (our previous EYC manager) and Miss Prater to the teaching team. Miss Nakamoto will be Eagles class teacher, Miss Hamilton will be Squirrels class teacher and Miss Prater has been employed one day a week to teach music throughout the school.
