Activities throughout the day

During the day the children will learn about their class's chosen country, meet via Zoom children and adults from a primary school in Brazil, have opportunity to participate in a talent competition (this will be arranged in school so no action at home is required), play traditional games from international countries, complete a traditional parade around the KS1 playground and taste food from an international country.
