Swimming

After the Christmas holidays swimming sessions will take place for year 3 on Friday afternoons from 1.30pm to 2.30pm at Chard Leisure Centre. The children will walk to the Leisure Centre with school staff and will be back at school for normal home time collection.

The children will be swimming until the February half term holiday and places will be strictly limited to 50 pupils allocated on a first come first served basis as determined by the ParentPay booking system. Places can be secured through the ParentPay website where payment will need to be made at the time of booking. The booking and first payment must be received by the end of Wednesday 5th January 2022.

The dates of each session are as follows:-

14th, 21st, 28th, January
4th, 11th, 18th February

If you would like your child to be included in swimming sessions, please login to your ParentPay account to reserve a place and make payment. **The cost of the sessions this half term is £17.70 (the equivalent of £2.95 per week) and has been subsidised by the school.**

Payment can be made in two instalments:-

1st Instalment of £8.85 by Wednesday 5th January 2022

2nd instalment of £8.85 by Wednesday 2nd February 2022

Please note that failure to make the 2nd instalment will mean that your child will not be able to participate in any further sessions after this date.

Please make sure your child has sufficient towels to dry their body and hair thoroughly. Please provide appropriate swimming costumes (not bikinis, tankinis or for the boys, long shorts). Teachers will be supervising the changing rooms. It is also advisable that children with long hair wear it plaited or tied back. Swimming hats may also be worn. Goggles are advisable.
