Reference: Houses of Parliament Visit

Dear Parents/Carers,

During the autumn term Year 6 will be learning about Margaret Bondfield and the development of democracy. To bring the topic to life we will be visiting the Houses of Parliament and the London Eye. The trip will take place on Friday 9th September 2022 and promises to be a very exciting and memorable day.

The school have kindly decided to subsidise part of this trip in the hope that as many of our children will get to experience going to our capital city. The total cost will be £26.16 per child. We are asking for a £10 deposit to be paid via ParentPay by Friday 22nd July 2022 (last day of term) this will secure your child a place and give us time to book the tickets for the London Eye. The rest of the payment is to be made by Friday 2nd September 2022.

On the day of the trip the coach will be leaving school at approximately 6.15am. Children should wear their school uniform and bring a raincoat. They may bring a book to read or a small toy or game to play with on the coach, however no electrical items, including phones or tablets are permitted. They should also bring 2 x 20p coins in case they need to use the public toilets in Victoria Tower Gardens while we wait for our tour to begin. Each child will need to bring a snack, a packed lunch and a packed tea with them, along with sufficient drinks for the day. If your child receives free school meals, we will be able to provide them with a packed lunch, but they will need to bring their own snacks and tea. We will eat lunch on arrival in London and stop at Fleet Services on our way home to eat our tea.

The coach will return to school at approximately 8pm. If we are later than expected, you will be informed via the school twitter account. Please note - due to the time of our return all children will need to be collected from school - children will not be permitted to walk home alone.
