Reference: Pupil voice survey

As you know we have recently completed the pupil voice survey prepared by Ofsted with each child (in Years 1 to 6) who attends our school. Children in the Foundation Stage were asked the questions on this occasion as we believed that they were mature enough to provide their thoughts.

The survey was completed confidentially, and the children were given opportunity and sufficient time to answer the questions carefully. We are delighted with the children's answers and wish to share them with you. We had over two hundred and fifty children's responses and believe that this sample is reflective of how the children feel and think about their educational experience at Manor Court Community Primary.

I enjoy school.	96% of the children answered yes to this question.
Adults help me to do my best.	96% of the children answered yes to this question.
My teachers give me work that challenges me.	93% of the children answered yes to this question.
I enjoy learning at school.	96% of the children answered yes to this question.
Adults listen to what I have to say.	98% of the children answered yes to this question.
There is an adult I can talk to if something is worrying me.	98% of the children answered yes to this question.
The behaviour of other children in my lesson is good.	98% of the children answered yes (all of the time, most of the time, usually) to this question.
The behaviour of other children around our school is good	98% of the children answered yes (all of the time, most of the time, usually) to this question.
Is bullying a problem in our school?	92% of the children answered no to this question.
I feel safe when at school.	98% of the children answered yes to this question.
Our school encourages me to look after my physical health (for example healthy eating and fitness)	97% of the children answered yes to this question.
Our school encourages me to look after my mental health.	98% of the children answered yes to this question.
I take part in school activities outside of lessons like clubs, sport, music, and art.	86% of the children answered yes to this question.
Our school encourages me to be independent and to take on responsibilities.	100% of the children answered yes to this question.
Our school encourages me to respect people from other backgrounds and to treat everyone equally.	98% of the children answered yes to this question
Our school provides me with information about the next steps in my learning.	94% of the children answered yes to this question.
I would recommend our school to a friend that is moving into the area.	98% of the children answered yes to this question.

Again, the answer that we are the most surprised by is that only 86% of the children attended school activities outside of the classroom lessons. We appreciate that this could be for a variety of reasons outside of our control and pride ourselves on the enrichment provision that we provide for our children. However, we are aware that this has not been as varied because of the Covid restrictions of the last two years and that we need to reconsider a system that enables more parents to book afterschool enrichment clubs online.
