## Year 4 Carnival Entry 2021

We are all very excited about the forthcoming carnival and are working very hard on our final preparations.

With this in mind, we are writing to confirm arrangements for those children taking part in Chard Carnival on the evening of **Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2021**. The children will need to arrive **at Manor Court School by 5.30pm**. There will then be a safety briefing and judging element before the **parade commences at 7.30pm**.

We would greatly appreciate it if children could have an early dinner at home before being dropped off at school; it is going to be a long evening and we really don't want the children being overly hungry. Whilst at school, we will provide the children with drinks and snacks to keep them going before the parade starts.

As previously mentioned, the children will need to wear either a pair of black leggings or trousers (this could even be their school trousers) for the carnival. If it is particularly cold, it might be worthwhile wearing an extra layer underneath (tights, leggings or another pair of joggers). In addition to this, the children will need to wear a long-sleeved t-shirt, preferably dark and plain which complement the bright reds and blues that will be worn over the top. Likewise with the bottoms, it might be beneficial if children wear an extra layer - vest or t-shirt – underneath their long-sleeved top.

As part of our costume, we are going to be using non-toxic face paints and glitter. These will obviously wash off, but if any child has a specific skin complaint or you would rather that we did not use these on your child, then we will need to know. If you are happy for your child to use face paints, could you please complete the permission slip on ParentPay by no later than **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> October 2021**.

Having spoken with the carnival committee, they believe that the route should take around an hour to complete. Therefore, could all parents/carers be **back at Manor Court School by 8.30pm** ready to collect their child.
