Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Year 3 Trip to Stonehenge - Tuesday 15th March 2022

To complement our work about The Stone Age, Year 3 will be visiting Stonehenge on Tuesday 15th March 2022.

The trip will help us to answer our enquiry question 'Was a Stone Age child healthier than a 21st century child?' and will include a visit to the stones themselves, an investigation into daily life in the late Stone Age and the chance to see inside a Neolithic house. We will leave school at 8.30am and return slightly later than normal at 3.30pm. Please ensure children are in school promptly. Children will need to bring a packed lunch, although children who have free school meals will be provided with a lunch. A snack and drink are advisable for all children.

Please be advised that there is no inside space for schools, so children should bring a waterproof/warm coat as well as a hat/gloves if it is due to be very cold. Children will need to wear school uniform and wear wellies/boots suitable for being outside all day, whatever the weather. We will, of course, take inhalers from school, but if your child suffers from travel sickness, please make sure they are given medication before travelling. If your child will require travel sickness medication for the return journey, please contact the school office for a medical form and hand both the completed form and medication to teachers on the day.

The trip will cost £10.50 per child, sign up and payment via ParentPay needs to be made by Friday 11th March 2022 at the latest.

There will be an opportunity for the children to visit the gift shop at the end of the day in small groups. Parents may send their child with no more than £5.00 in a named envelope to spend in the shop if they wish.
