Reference: Results of our online Parental Survey

It is a pleasure to share with you the results of our parental survey that we conducted for three weeks online before the October half term holidays. As always, the questions in this survey were taken from the Ofsted Parent View Survey and we encourage you to complete the official Ofsted survey which can be found at www.parentview.ofsted.gov.uk

My child is happy at this school.	99% of responses agreed or strongly agreed with this statement. 1% of responses disagreed with this statement.
My child feels safe at this school.	98% of responses agreed or strongly agreed with this statement. 2% of responses disagreed with this statement.
The school makes sure that the pupils are well behaved.	92% of responses agreed or strongly agreed with this statement 3% said that they did not know. 5% of responses disagreed with this statement.
My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively.	25% of responses agreed or strongly agreed with this statement. 3% said that they did not know. 64% of responses stated that their child has not been bullied. 8% of responses disagreed with this statement.
The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the school year.	82% of responses agreed or strongly agreed with this statement. 2% said that they did not know. 16% of responses disagreed with this statement.
When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.	59% of responses agreed or strongly agreed with this statement. 3% said that they did not know. 31% of responses stated that they have not raised any concerns. 7% of responses disagreed with this statement.
Does your child have special educational needs and or a disability (SEND)?	9% of responses answered yes to this statement. 91% of responses answered no to this statement.
If you have answered yes that your child has special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND), does the school give you the support that you need?	67% of responses answered yes to this question. 33% of responses answered no to this question.
The school has high expectations for my child.	87% of responses agreed or strongly agreed with this statement. 2% of responses disagreed with this statement. 10% of responses stated that they do not know.
My child does well at this school.	97% of responses agreed or strongly agreed with this statement. 3% of responses stated that they do not know.
The school lets me know how well my child is doing at school.	81% of responses agreed or strongly agreed with this statement. 16% of responses disagreed with this statement. 3% of responses stated that they do not know.
There are a good range of subjects available to my child at this school.	92% of responses agreed or strongly agreed with this statement. 8% of responses stated that they do not know.
My child can take part in enrichment clubs and activities at this school.	90% of responses agreed or strongly agreed with this statement. 2% of responses disagreed with this statement. 2% of responses strongly disagreed with this statement 6% of responses stated that they do not know.

The school supports my child's wider personal development.	81% of responses agreed or strongly agreed with this statement. 14% of responses stated that they do not know. 5% of responses disagreed with this statement.
I would recommend this school to another parent.	96% of responses stated that they would recommend the school to another parent. 4% of responses stated that they would not recommend the school to another parent.

The answer that surprised us the most is that only 82% of parents agreed or strongly agreed that they are informed as to what their child will be learning in school. Each term we send home via email or Eylog the curriculum sheet for the term and upload this document to the website. In future we will ensure that a printed copy is sent home via your child to ensure that parents have this.
