Dear Year 4 Parent/Carer,

re: Year 4 visit to Drift Education at Horn Farm, Forton

Our Year 4 science topic this term is 'animals including humans' and they will be learning all about the digestive system, teeth and food chains.

To develop the children's understanding of this topic, we will be **visiting a local farm in Forton for the day on Friday 14th February 2020**. The children will leave just after morning registration and will be back at school by 3pm to go home at the usual time. There is no charge for this visit.

Whilst at the farm, the children will learn about how the animal's digestive system affects its nutrition and how this changes as they grow and develop.

It is important to note that this is a working farm and therefore children should dress appropriately. They do not need to wear school uniform but instead should wear warm clothes that they are happy to get slightly dirty. They must bring a waterproof coat. They should wear suitable footwear for a muddy farm, such as wellies. Children need to bring a spare pair of clean shoes in a named plastic bag that they can change into for the coach journey home.

Children should bring a packed lunch and drink with them. If your child usually has a hot school lunch, they will be provided with a packed lunch on the day.

If you would like your child to attend this trip, please respond on Parent Pay to confirm their attendance by Friday 7th February to give consent and to acknowledge the clothing/footwear requirements.
