YEAR 4 RESIDENTIAL TRIP TO WILDWOOD ESCOT

School residential trips are a valuable part of every child's primary education. We are excited to announce that we have organised a residential experience for our Year 4 children this academic year at Wildwood Escot. The education centre is half an hour away, between Honiton and Ottery St Mary in Devon. The children will be staying in a yurt, and will take part in a variety of mini-adventures including team-building, swamp walking, meeting wolves, lynx and wild boar, exploring forests, a maze and large outside play areas.

The visit will take place between Thursday 11th and Friday 12th June 2019. Like last year, the cost will be £78 per child which covers activities, transport, accommodation and food and drink while at the centre. The children will leave Manor Court to arrive at Wildwood Escot at 10am on the Thursday and return back to school by 3pm on the Friday. A packed lunch will be needed for the Thursday. Children who have booked a school meal or have free school meals will have a packed lunch provided. An extra drink and snack is advisable for all children.

There is some funding available to support families who are known by us to be eligible for pupil premium. Please contact Mrs Hunt in the school office for further information.

A non-refundable deposit of £20.00 should be paid to secure a place on the trip by Friday 1st November 2019 at the latest. **Please note that deposits cannot be accepted after this date resulting in the child not being able to participate.** Deposits should be paid through your ParentPay account.

The remaining balance for the trip will need to be paid in instalments (dates will be given in a subsequent letter) by Monday 11th May 2019.

Further information concerning what your child will need for the visit, consent and medical forms will be sent out nearer the time. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate in seeing us on the playground or arranging an appointment with us.
