Dear Parents and Carers,

Our Summer show, 'An Evening of Song and Dance' is finally upon us! Here are the final details, most of which you have received already, but will all be in one place and hopefully answer any questions you may have.

Choir and Dance Club members are performing on both nights.

Dancers need to arrive at the back of the Guildhall between 5:00 and 5:15pm, wearing their decorated top, dark bottoms and Daps or trainers with long hair tied back. They need to bring their coloured top for their class song.

Choir members need to arrive at the back of the Guildhall between 5:30 and 5:45pm, wearing their decorated t-shirt and school shorts, skirt or trousers and shoes. They need to bring their coloured top for their class song.

Foundation, Year 1 and Year 6 need to arrive at the back of the Guildhall between 5:30 and 5:45pm, ready for the show starting at 6:00pm.

Year 2, 3, 4 and 5 need to arrive at school between 5:30 and 5:45pm – entering through the top door by the Hall, as for Celebration Assembly.

All children in Foundation to Year 5 who are not members of Choir, are to come dressed in their coloured top with school shorts, skirt or trousers and shoes. Year 6 are to come in their Annie costume.

All children are to bring a drink and a packed tea/snacks, unless they are having an early tea at home first.

After the show, children will be dismissed from three different doors, as there are over 100 children to be collected each night. Parents and carers will be asked to wait outside that door and your children will need to be ticked off a register by their Class Teacher as they see you, and then handed to you. This will take a few minutes but I am sure you appreciate this is for their own safety.

If you have more than one child, please collect the younger sibling first. Dancers and Choir members will return to the dressing rooms to collect their belongings and be brought back to their year group's door to be dismissed. Children walking from school will leave any belongings there and bring them home from school the following day (unless it is raining, and they have brought coats – their class teacher will have them in a large container at the exit). All doors will be clearly labelled.

Foundation and Year 1 – side door through the cafeteria, to the right of the stage

Year 2 and 3 – foyer door at the front of the auditorium

Years 4, 5, 6 – back double doors (behind Guildhall opposite Lidl)

There are still a few tickets available for each night, and can be bought from the Guildhall Box Office next Monday – Thursday, 9:30am – 5:30pm, including show days, or this Friday from 9:30am – 4:30pm.
