| ALL ORPHANS | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Dull coloured (e.g., brown, beige or grey) full dress OR a dull coloured (e.g., brown, beige or grey) jumper with a blouse/shirt underneath and dull coloured leggings/trousers. - Worn black or brown boots or shoes. |
| MISS HANNIGAN | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gaudy dress (lots of colour, big prints) - Slippers (not too modern) - Tights (Tan or Black) - Black flats or black boots - Long beaded necklace, bracelets - Long thin head scarf |
| GRACE FARRELL | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fitted feminine suit (jacket and a skirt) OR 1930's style dress in any colour - Tights (Tan) - Black flats or black boots - Long coat/long trench coat |
