YEAR 4 RESIDENTIAL TRIP TO WILDWOOD, ESCOT, NEAR HONITON

This letter is a quick reminder about the residential trip to Wildwood, Escot on Thursday 13th June to Friday 14th June 2019.

- The pupils will need to arrive at the normal time, bringing all of their kit with them – please note that whatever the children bring will need to be carried by them.
- The children do not need to wear school uniform on Thursday 13th June and should come to school dressed appropriately for a coach journey and outdoor activities.
- You will need to provide your child with a packed lunch for the first day. If your children receives free school meals, we will provide a packed lunch for them.
- Please check the kit list for what your child will need to bring but a small rucksack, a plastic drinks bottle, sun cream, sun hat and rain coat are essential.
- All medication can be given to Mrs Terry from 8:30am on the Thursday morning in Puffins classroom. Please ensure all medication is clearly labelled.
- Children can bring up to £5 spending money – the money needs to be in a labelled wallet/purse or envelope and given to your child's class teacher for safe-keeping.
- Children are **not** to bring **any mobile phones** or electrical devices – pupils may bring a camera but it will be the responsibility of the child to look after it and no responsibility will be taken by the school for any damage or loss. We will take iPads for the children to take photos on.
- Please pack old clothes for the swamp walk, and a carrier bag to keep these clothes in afterwards.
- The yurts do not have lights inside, so a torch will be needed for night time.
- Please ensure children do not bring or wear any jewellery or make-up.
- We are leaving Manor Court at approximately 9.20am, if you wish to wave them off.
- The adults attending are: Mrs Terry, Miss Thompson, Mrs Gray and Mrs Willmington.
- Children can be collected from school at 3:15pm on Friday, not before.
