Dear Parents and Carers,

## **Reference: An evening of Song and Dance**

As you are aware, we are having our first big show at the Guildhall on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July. The show is 'An Evening of Song and Dance' and will include performances from KS1 and KS2 Choirs, KS1 and KS2 Dance Clubs, and every class will sing one song and return for the finale. If your child is not in Choir or Dance Club, and they do not wish to participate, they do not have to. However, the more children who perform, the more enjoyable the evening will be for all.

Due to the capacity backstage at the Guildhall, there is not enough room for all children, even with splitting the year groups in half to wait there. Therefore, children in Choir and Dance Club will spend the whole show at the Guildhall, but all other children will spend much of the show at school, and will be walked to the Guildhall and back to school either side of their performance, and then back to the Guildhall for the finale, where all children can be collected.

Year 6 and Foundation Stage children will be performing near the start of the show, so will require to need to be taken directly to the Guildhall between 5:30 and 5:45pm. They will perform and then go back to school, and return to the Guildhall for the finale, where they will be collected. If your child is in Foundation or Year 1 (and not in Choir or Dance Club), and you think that returning for the finale will be too much for them, you are welcome to collect them from school after the interval. We have estimated that the show will finish at 8pm.


