Our exciting residential for the Year 5 children is fast approaching and we are now in the process of putting together all the information you will need.

With regard to the Parental Consent Form, please read all the information carefully and complete every section of the form marking 'not applicable' if the section does not apply.

Also attached is the kit list detailing what your child will need for their time at the Ultimate Adventure Centre. Please label all belongings clearly so that items can be returned should they become mislaid. We cannot accept responsibility for any items, so please do consider carefully the items your child takes with them.

When packing kit bags with your child, please remember to use a suitable holdall/suitcase that your child will be able to carry themselves. Also include a couple of black plastic bags for dirty clothes to be put into.

Please do not pack any electronic items such as phones, tablets, game consoles etc. Aerosol spray cans such as deodorant, etc are also not permitted.

If your child requires medication whilst away, we will forward additional forms to be completed nearer the time.

All children will require a packed lunch for their first day, 1st July. As the first day of the residential is on a Monday, we are unable to provide lunches for those children who are entitled to free school meals or paid for lunch so all children will need to take a lunch from home for that day. Please provide your child with plenty to drink for the day in a reusable plastic bottle.
