Thank you for allowing your child to take part in the Manor Court School walking entry in this year's Chard Children's Carnival on Saturday 13th October.

The procession route follows along Duck Lane, down the High Street, and ending in the Lace Mill car park. Your child will be supervised at all times by Manor Court staff who will then walk the children back to Manor Court where they can be collected.
