Dear Parents/Carers

Our Year 4 curriculum topic this term is learning about how carnivals bring people together. We will be studying carnivals in Somerset, namely Chard, and carnivals across the other side of the world in Brazil. We will be comparing their similarities and differences. In light of this, and to give our children the experience of participating in a real life carnival, we have decided to enter the Chard Children's Carnival on Saturday 13th October. We would like your child to be part of our entry.

The children will need to be at Manor Court School at 10.30am on Saturday 13th October. There will then be a safety briefing and judging element before the procession leaves at 12 noon.

The procession route follows along Duck Lane, down the High Street, and ending in the Lace Mill car park. Your child will be supervised at all times by Manor Court staff who will then walk the children back to Manor Court where they can be collected.
