YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL TRIP TO MINEHEAD ADVENTURE CENTRE, BUTLINS

This letter is a quick reminder about the residential trip to Minehead on Monday 4th June 2018 until Friday 8th June 2018.

- The pupils will need to arrive in school at the normal time, bringing all of their kit with them – please note that whatever the children bring will need to be carried by them.
- On Monday, children do not need to wear school uniform and should come to school dressed appropriately for a coach journey and sports activities.
- If your children receives free school meals, you will need to provide a packed lunch on the Monday as, due to half-term, we are unable to get a packed lunch prepared.
- Please check the kit list for what your child will need to bring but a small rucksack, a plastic drinks bottle, sun cream, sun hat, swimming costume and rain coat will be essential.
- All medication can be given to Mr Glentworth from 8:30am on the Monday morning in Herons classroom. Please ensure all medication is clearly labelled.
- Children can bring up to £5 spending money – it is suggested that the money is in a labelled wallet/purse and given to Mr Glentworth for safe-keeping.
- Children are **not** to bring **any mobile phones** or electrical devices – pupils may bring a camera but it will be the responsibility of the child to look after it and no responsibility will be taken by the school for any damage or loss.
- We are leaving Manor Court at 11.15am if you wish to wave them off for the week.
- The adults attending are: Mr Glentworth, Miss Gregory, Mrs Stoker, Mrs Barbour (all week) and Mrs Terry (Mon- Wed) with Mr Talmage (Wed-Fri).
- Children can be collected from school at 3:15pm on Friday.
