Dear Parents / Carers

As you know, the Year 4 residential to Escot Wildwood is next week (Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> - Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> April). Your child needs to come dressed ready for the trip, and not in school uniform, on Wednesday.

Here are some reminders for you:

- The children will leave Manor Court on Wednesday 25th April shortly after 9am to arrive at Escot for 10am.
- Your child will need a packed lunch with them to eat on the Wednesday. Children who have school lunches will be provided with a packed lunch. Bring a refillable drinks bottle.
- The children will be provided with an evening meal on the Wednesday, breakfast on Thursday morning, and a packed lunch on the Thursday. No food needs to be provided for the second day.
- We will be leaving at 2pm on the Thursday to make it back to school for the end of the day.
- We will be having a camp fire before bedtime. The children will be sleeping in yurts. Please ensure their bedding and pyjamas will keep them warm at night.
- When Mrs Terry visited the site last week it was very wet underfoot. It is likely that wellies or walking boots will be worn most of the time due to the muddy conditions. Pack some extra socks to keep toes nice and dry.
- The children take part in a swamp walk and need separate old clothes for this. They do get badly stained so ideally something you don't mind getting very dirty. The children are hosed down after this! There are showers on site but we can't force your child to have one!
- No electronics allowed (phones, computer games, tablets, etc.)
- Your child may bring a maximum of £5.00 to spend in the gift shop before returning home. This must be in a clearly named purse or envelope, and will be handed in to their teacher on Wednesday morning.
- Any medication that needs to accompany your child must be clearly labelled and handed over to an adult on Wednesday morning.
