### Inter-school Cross-Country Competition

Dear Parent/Carer

Your child has been invited to take part in a competitive cross-country run at Holyrood Academy next Tuesday, 16<sup>th</sup> January.

The children will walk to Holyrood for a 2.00pm start, and will have a warm-up before the race. There will be four races, with boys and girls running separately. Years 3 and 4 will be running approximately 900m, and years 5 and 6 will run approximately 1400m. The races will end at 3.30pm, therefore you will need to make suitable arrangements to collect your child from Holyrood or give permission for them to walk home (years 4 – 6 only). Your child must wear the agreed Manor Court PE kit (navy t-shirt and navy shorts), and trainers. It is advisable that your child wear old trainers because the course may be wet/muddy. No daps please as the children will be running on wet muddy ground. Please also ensure your child has a waterproof coat, an extra drink and snack is advisable.

If you would like your child to take part and represent Manor Court School please fill in the slip below and return to the Office by **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> January latest**. A proportion of the children that finish the races the quickest will go on to run against other schools in Somerset this year.
