Our annual multicultural event will be held on **Friday 24th April**. This is an event that promotes empathy for other cultures and awareness of the world we live within. It's also a day to celebrate and embrace all the cultures that we have at our school.

The highlight this year will be 'The Great MC Bake Off'. Children are able to bake a traditional cake (from any country they wish) at home with parents and bring it to school, please label these with your child's name. Children will sample the cakes within their year group, vote on their favourite to choose a winner who will then receive a medal. The following week we will announce, during assembly who is the 'MC Bake Off' overall winner judged by Mr Clode who will then receive a trophy.

This is an opportunity for children to sample some traditional cakes from other countries, but please do remember we are a **NUT FREE** environment, please be mindful when baking your cakes. If you are making a cake, please can we ask that you write a list of ingredients used for us to place next to the cake so we can be allergen aware.

We are also hosting an artefact exhibition with a range of artefacts from around the world, teachers will be taking their classes throughout the day to visit this. During the day children will learn about their class countries and will do a variety of traditional activities, and for the big finale we will have a parade on the playground where child will have the opportunity to show their outfits, colours and flags.

- Owls – Madagascar – white, red and green
- Eagles – Vietnam – red and yellow
- Puffins – Brazil – green and yellow
- Badgers – France – blue, white and red
- Foxes – Australia- blue, white and red
- Herons – Portugal – red and green
- Otters – Wales – white, green and red (dragon)
