PETER PAN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Traditional green outfit with pockets or pouch for fairy dust, • acorn necklace.
WENDY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Long nightgown(old-fashioned if possible). • A foliage necklace/headband
JOHN/MICHAEL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Old-fashioned PJS • John – top hat • Simple jacket
MR DARLING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dark-coloured suit and tie
MRS DARLING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smart long skirt • blouse • a shawl
TINKERBELL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Traditional fairy outfit with wings (forest colours if possible) • A light to go around her neck that can be switched on and off. • Bells on her skirt or shoes
CAPTAIN HOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smart pirate outfit • Elaborate pirate hat • Large hook • Fancy hat for the end
PIRATES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Traditional pirate outfits • Eye patch • Cutlass/sword
SHIP'S COOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An apron • Chef's hat with a skull and crossbones on.
LOST BOYS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • T-shirts/shorts in forest colours with foliage added. • Simple Jacket
WILD WARRIORS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warrior-style outfit • Wild hair (so hair gel needed!)

CHIEF + TIGER LILY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warrior-style outfit • Crown/Tiara with a wild hairdo • Gold sash around its waist
MERMAIDS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leotard or top • Anything sparkly/glittery • Long skirt to be made into a tail.
NANA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dog-coloured top and leggings with doggy mask. • Doggy ears and a tail. • Old fashioned nanny-type cap and small apron.
CROC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Green top and trousers/leggings • Crocodile head mask • Pointed tail
LIZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Long black skirt • White blouse • Apron
SHADOW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black trousers • Black top with hood
FAIRIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fairy outfit with wings in forest colours.
