



Year 6 Curriculum Plan- Summer Term 2026

English

To begin the term, we will be revising the key grammar terminology for KS2. Reading comprehension will continue to be taught daily. Later in the term, we will be reading a range of exciting texts including Wonder by R J Palacio, Floodland by Marcus Sedgwick and Cinderella. These texts will inspire lots of exciting writing (stories, diary entries, newspaper reports, persuasive adverts and discussion texts to name a few).

Maths

This we will revise all the key concepts the children have learned over KS2. We will then apply these skills to a range of exciting and real-life problems. There will also be a daily focus on arithmetic and problem solving.

Science

Our first topic is Evolution. We will learn about Charles Darwin and his scientific theories. After half term our topic will be Living things and their Habitats, which will include how animals and plants adapt to their surroundings.

Geography

We will be learning about the Americas and comparing the physical and human geography of the Americas to the UK.

History

We will be learning about crime and punishment from the Roman times to the present day.

Key vocabulary

Geography- fieldwork, human geography, physical geography, continent, climate, land use, characteristics, state.

History-bobbies, deterrent, execution, highwaymen, judge, jury, ordeal, treason, victim, trial.

Science- offspring, inheritance, variations, characteristics, adaptation, habitat, environment. characteristics, classify, taxonomist, key.
