Foundation PSHE - Physical Health and Wellbeing

Dear Parent/Carer,

Promoting the health and well-being of our pupils is an important part of children's overall education. We do this through our Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE) curriculum. This looks at many topics including physical and emotional health, all kinds of relationships and living in the wider world.

In the next few weeks, our school will be focusing on part of the SCARF PSHE scheme to deliver the relationships and sex education (RSE) lessons to Foundation children. They will be learning about keeping their bodies healthy, managing feelings, being a good friend and the safe use of medicines.

It became a legal requirement in September 2020 for relationships and sex education to be taught across the school, in an age and developmentally appropriate way. The design of the programme has taken into account the requirements of the statutory guidance, up-to-date best practice guidance and the needs of our children.

We recognise that parents and carers play a vital part in their child's RSE, and we encourage you to talk with your child about this at home as well. If further advice/support is required, or you have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's class teacher.

In addition, there will be an opportunity to hear more about the importance of RSE through a Zoom meeting with Julia Ship (a SCARF representative). More information will be sent in a separate letter, along with a link to access the meeting.
