Club Descriptions

Club Name	Description
Homework	Homework club provides an opportunity for the children to complete their homework in a familiar environment with supportive resources, adults, and peers.
Colouring Club	Colouring club is an opportunity for your child's artistic skills to flourish.

Book Club	Book Club is an opportunity for book worms to get together to talk about books, share thoughts and recommend reads to others.
Cheerleading Club	A team sport for boys and girls where children learn stunts, jumps, tumblers, and dance for fast paced routine.
Ukulele Club	Somerset Music Academy will be coming into school to run a Ukulele Club during Monday lunchtimes in The Library. Spaces are limited but a great opportunity for your child to learn an instrument.

Inventors and Innovators (DT)	We will explore the work of different inventors, innovators and engineers and design and develop our own products to help address real-world problems.
