## Swimming

After October half term, swimming sessions will take place for Year 4 on Thursday afternoons from 1.30pm to 2.30pm at Chard Leisure Centre. The children will walk to the leisure centre with school staff and will be back at school for normal home time collection.

The children will be swimming until the week before we break for Christmas. Places can be secured through your ParentPay account where payment will need to be made in full at the time of booking. The booking and payment must be received by the end of **Friday 24<sup>th</sup> October 2025** to secure your child's place.

The dates of each session are as follows: -

6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> November  
4<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> December

If you would like your child to be included in swimming sessions, please login to your ParentPay account to reserve a place and make payment. **The cost of the sessions this half term is £22.39 (the equivalent of just under £4.00 per week).** Spaces are limited to 48.

Please make sure your child has sufficient towels to dry their body and hair thoroughly. Please provide appropriate swimwear (no tankinis or bikinis). Teachers will be supervising the changing rooms. It is also advisable that children with long hair wear it plaited or tied back. Swimming hats may also be worn. Goggles are advisable.
