This year in computing, we will be using Autodesk Tinkercad, which is an easy-to-use app for 3D design, electronics, and coding, that encourages creativity, critical thinking, and collaboration. Tinkercad is a free and web-based application. This means that students may access and work on their designs both at school and at home using almost any computer that is connected to the internet, without having to install any software. By using Tinkercad, your child will be joining the largest community of 3D design, 3D printing, and electronics enthusiasts of its kind.
